Vintage American Cocktails

Take a whistle stop tour of a few of the fifty US states which inspired some of the most popular and well known cocktail recipes ever

- Cape Cod Cooler** 48
Made from cranberry juice, soda and freshly squeezed lime juice, this cocktail recipe is believed to be named after the area around Cape Cod in the state of Massachusetts which produces America's second largest cranberry crop

- Long Island Ice Tea** 55
This cocktail was created during the Prohibition era in the 1920's and was thought to look like Iced Tea – hence the name. However just to re-assure you, it has absolutely no tea in it but does contain a range of alcohol ingredients you are likely to have in your drinks collection: White Rum, Gin, Tequila, Triple Sec and Vodka with a splash of lime.

- Lynchburg Lemonade** 48
Lynchburg, Tennessee is the home town of the Jack Daniels Distillery, set up by Jack at the age of 20 in 1870. Not Bourbon, Tennessee whiskey is filtered through up to 12 feet of maple charcoal, taking up to 10 days, giving it a unique aroma and flavor. Made with Jack Daniels Tennessee whiskey, Triple Sec, Lemon juice and topped up with Lemonade.

- Miami** 42
In Florida we have the Miami cocktail. The color of this cocktail was inspired by the local Florida Everglades or even the pastel colored designer suits worn by Don Johnson in the 1980's Miami vice TV series. Whatever its origin, this is an exquisite blend of White Rum and Crème De Menthe balanced with a dash of lemon juice. A cocktail to be seen with!

- Sunset Boulevard** 40
This cocktail was inspired by the stylish boulevard and by the 1950's film of the same name, starring Norma Desmond – later reworked into the successful stage musical by Andrew Lloyd Webber. An elegant combination of Vodka, Peach Schnapps mixed with cranberry and orange juice. This will make you feel like a movie star!

Small Town, Big Surprise!

a trip down memory lane you'll never forget!

"It takes a smart brunette to play a dumb blonde." Marilyn Monroe

On June 1, 1926 Norma Jeane Mortenson was born in Los Angeles, California. Subsequently her mother Gladys changed their surname to Baker.

During her all-too-brief life, Marilyn Monroe overcame a difficult childhood she never knew her father. Her mother Gladys developed psychiatric problems and was eventually placed in a mental institution. Growing up, Monroe spent much of her childhood in foster care and in an orphanage.

In 1937, a family friend and her husband, Grace and Doc Goddard, took care of her for a few years. When Doc's job was transferred in 1942 to the East Coast, the couple could not afford to bring Monroe with them. Despising the idea of going back to the orphanage, at only 16 years old Monroe married James Dougherty.

In 1944, Monroe and a few other women who worked with her at Radioplane were asked to pose

for photographs by a military unit making a film for army training purposes. This is Monroe's overnight success story becoming one of the world's biggest and most enduring sex symbols.

She had three spouses: James Dougherty 1942 – 1946, Joe DiMaggio 1954 – 1954, Arthur Miller 1956 – 1961.

On May 19, 1962 Monroe made her last significant public appearance singing, "Happy birthday" at a birthday party for President John. F. Kennedy at Madison Square Garden. The dress she wore to the event, specially designed for her by Jean Louis, sold at an auction in 1999 for USD \$ 26 million.

Sadly on August 5, 1962, Marilyn Monroe died in her home in Los Angeles at the age of 36. Joe DiMaggio claimed her body and arranged her funeral. For 20 years he delivered half a dozen roses to her crypt three times a week.

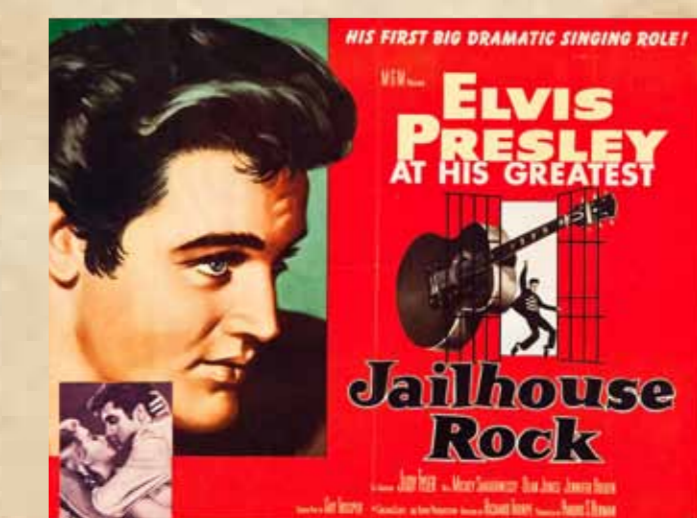

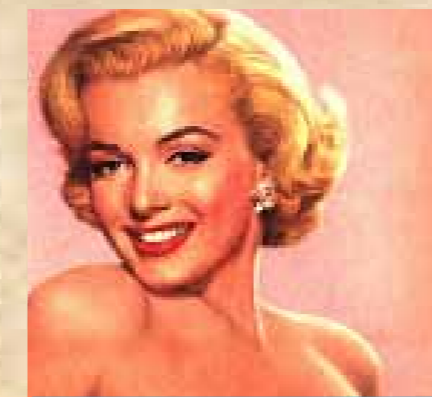
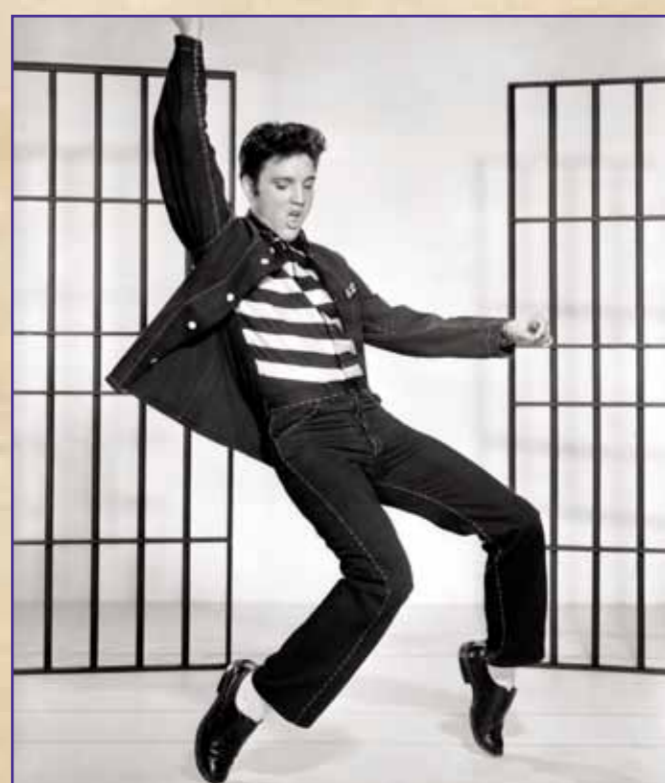
Elvis Aaron Presley, in the humblest of circumstances, was born to Vernon and Gladys Presley in a two bedded room in Tupelo, Mississippi on January 8, 1935. His twin brother, Jessie Garon was still born, leaving Elvis to grow up as an only child. He and his parents moved to Memphis, Tennessee in 1948, and Elvis graduated from Humes High School there in 1953.

Elvis' musical influences were the pop and country music of the time. In 1954, he began his singing career with the legendary Sun Records label in Memphis. With a sound and style that uniquely combined his diverse musical influences and blurred and challenged the social and racial barriers of the time, he ushered in a whole new era of American music and popular culture.

He starred in 33 successful films and made history with his television appearances and specials. Without any of the special privileges his celebrity status might have afforded him, he honorably served his country in the U.S. Army.

His talent, good looks, sensuality, charisma and good humor endeared him to million's, as did the humility and human kindness he demonstrated throughout his life. Known the world over by his first name, he is regarded as one of the most important figures of twentieth century popular culture.

Elvis died at his Memphis home, Graceland, on August 16, 1977.
